Since mid-March, our team of Worcester Polytechnic Institute students has been working closely with the local organization It's The People's Data, and key members of city government, to gather together and host data about Santa Fe in a central repository. Some examples of the data we have acquired include education results, crimes, and election contributions/expenditures. We have developed dashboards for viewing these data in different ways.

In our presentation, the WPI Open Data team will summarize our findings and offer recommendations for how Santa Fe can move effectively towards greater transparency in government.
